Lauderdale campus, and Palm Beach Community College, Boca or Lake Worth campuses). The final three phases, leading to the professional bachelor of Architecture, will total 99 semester hours. Students must complete a minimum of 159 credit hours to receive the Bachelor of Architecture degree.
