### PROGRAM OF STUDY AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Complete the AA degree at the community college. Some courses for the major may also meet the General Education requirements thereby transferring maximum hours to the university.

If you transfer without an AA degree and have less than 60 semester hours of acceptable credit, you must meet the university's entering freshman requirements including ACT or SAT test scores and GPA.
