The Health Administration curriculum provides students with a university education that promotes personal and professional growth as well as concentrated awareness of health systems and their effects on society. Health Administration is concentrated at the upper division of the baccalaureate program. Flexibility in course selection encourages students to develop a program of study that will strengthen their analytical skills; expose them to new thought; and develop awareness of leadership and responsibility as future health administrators. The graduate of this program is prepared to assume entry managerial positions in health; to continue the study of Health Administration, or other relevant disciplines, at the graduate level; and to advance to Health Administration positions with broader responsibility and leadership.

**PROGRAM OF STUDY AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

Complete the A.A. degree at the community college. Some courses required for the major may also meet the General Education Requirements thereby transferring maximum hours to the university.

If you transfer without an A.A. degree and have less than 60 semester credits of acceptable credit, you must meet the university’s entering freshman requirements including ACT or SAT test scores and GPA.

Students are encouraged to complete the following required common prerequisites during the program of study at the community college:
