**PROGRAM OF STUDY AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

Complete the A. A. degree at the community college. Some courses required for the major may also meet the General Education Requirements, thereby transferring maximum hours to the university.

If you transfer without an A. A. degree and have less than 60 semester hours of acceptable credit, you must meet the University's entering freshmen requirements, including ACT or SAT test scores and GPA.

Students are encouraged to complete the following required common prerequisites during the program of study at the community college:

- (P\*) Introduction to Education (EDF 2005) 3
- (P\*) Teaching Diverse Students (EDG 2701) 3
- (P\*) Introduction to Educational Technology (EME 2040) 3

(P\*)=Students may be admitted to FAU upper-division without having completed this course; however, the course must be completed before graduation and may cause excess hours.

**ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO THE UNIVERSITY PROGRAM OF STUDY**

Please be aware of the immunization, foreign language, and continuous enrollment policies of the University. Entrance Requirements: GPA of 2.5 or higher on the general education component of undergraduate studies, and passing scores on the General Knowledge examination and passing scores or exemptions on all sections of the CLAST examination are required for admission to all teacher education programs.

NOTE: If a prospective student took and passed all sections of the CLAST prior to June 30, 2002, there is no need to take the General Knowledge test.
