Program of Study at the Community College

Complete the A.A. degree at the community college. Some courses required for the major may also meet the General Education Requirements thereby transferring maximum hours to the university.

If you transfer without an A.A. degree and have less than 60 semester hours of acceptable credit, you must meet the university's entering freshman requirements including ACT or SAT test scores and GPA.

Students are encouraged to complete the following required common prerequisites during the program of study at the community college:

- (P*) Introduction to Educational Technology (EME 2040) (3 cr)
- (P*) Introduction to Education (EDF 2005) (3 cr)
- (P*) Teaching diverse populations (EDG 2701) (3cr)
- (P*) Applied Music (MVx x1x1 & MVx x2x2)** (4-8 crs)
- (P*) Applied Music: Piano (or Secondary piano proficiency by examination)** (4 cr)
- (P*) Music Theory I, II, III and IV (MUT 1111, MUT 1112, MUT 2116 & MUT 2117) (4 cr)
- (P*) Performance Ensemble (MUN xxxx)** (4 cr)
- (P*) Sight Singing and Ear Training I-IV (MUT 1241, MUT 1242, MUT 2246 & MUT 2247) (4 cr)

**It is suggested that students complete two years of study in Applied Music and Music Theory as part of the lower-division program. An audition and a placement examination in music theory, music history, aural skills, and piano will determine final music admission status based on departmental standards.

(P*)=Students may be admitted to FAU upper-division without having completed this course, however, the course must be completed before graduation and may cause excess hours.

Admission Requirements to the University Program of Study

Entrance Requirements: GPA of 2.5 or higher in the general education component of undergraduate studies and passing scores on all sections of the CLAST examination or, if exempt, general Knowledge passing scores, are required for admission to all teacher education programs.
