

THEATRE AND DANCE—MINOR IN DANCE

Silent Advisor 2023-2024

The Department of Theatre and Dance offers a minor in Dance, available to all undergraduate students with an audition demonstrating requisite dance experience. Auditions are scheduled once per semester and, if passed, allow students to declare the minor and register for classes the following semester. The Dance minor requires a minimum of 18 credits, 9 of which must be upper-division courses. At least 75 percent of all credits must be earned from FAU.

- All students are welcome to Audition for any shows within the department.
- All students minoring in theatre must fulfill the University and College requirements for admission and graduation.
- All courses in the department must be passed with a "C" or better; pass/fail grades are not allowed.
- At least 75% (13 hours) must be earned while in residency at FAU
- Each student must see a departmental advisor each semester before registering.
- Dance courses must be taken in sequence (Ex. Modern Dance 1, then Modern Dance 2)
- Level 1 skills classes are repeatable for credit.
