APPLYING TO THE HONORS COLLEGE AT FAU

Admissions are based on a student's qualifications and the space available. Admission is not guaranteed. Generally, successful transfer applicants have a minimum 3.5 GPA.

Transfer students are required to submit high school transcripts and test scores, as well as:

- 2 letters of evaluation, 1 from your current school
- 1 typed analytical paper of 500-1000 words
- 1 resume listing honors, awards, extracurricular activities, work experience, community service, etc

The College also requires students to live on the Jupiter campus unless they qualify for one or more exemptions:

- over the age of 26
- under the age of 18, living with parent/guardian
- married
- dependent children
- home ownership prior to admission
- documented "extraordinary conditions"

Before admissions, students are encouraged to complete two consecutive lower-division courses of one foreign language to meet the university's foreign language graduation requirement (ex. SPN x101 and SPN x102).
