PROGRAM OF STUDY AT COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Students must transfer specific courses totaling to 60 credits if they wish to apply directly to the B.S.N. The following list is grouped by general category; all courses must be evaluated and approved by the program advisor.

Additionally, any prerequisite course requires a minimum grade of "C." However, the program has a requirement of a minimum 3.0 GPA, which translates to a "B" average.

APPLYING TO THE COLLEGE OF NURSING

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing is a Limited Access Program. Acceptance into the program is not guaranteed.

NOVEMBER 30, 2008

Students must be admitted to FAU (must list Nursing as the major and May as the start date) and submit a College of Nursing Undergraduate Application.

DECEMBER 31, 2008

Students must have completed the HESI Entrance Exam with a minimum score of 80% in each category.

MAY 1, 2009

Students must have fulfilled all requirements, including the 60 prerequisite credits.

STUDENTS MUST ALSO...

Submit evidence of current health insurance.

Complete required health forms and immunizations.

Assume responsibility for transportation to and from all off-campus clinical experience courses.

Provide evidence of BLS certification for Health Care Providers through the American Heart Association; it must be valid for the entire academic year, resubmitted annually.

Meet all health requirements necessary for practicing in specific clinical agencies.

Possess basic computer knowledge such as e-mail, word processing, the Internet.

Purchase basic tools and equipment for nursing practice as well as preparatory learning materials for NCLEX.

Submit to a background check and a drug screening.
