Although the overall Greek GPA dropped this semester individual Greeks did very well. The number of Greeks with 4.0 increased, and the number of Greeks with a 3.0 GPA continues to increase. Fraternities this semester most of your chapter GPA's have lowered by a few points. Some chapter GPA's weren't listed because they did not have enough members on their roster or enough enrolled this semester to be fairly compared to other Greek chapters.

This semester's grade reports also list each member of your organization who is on probation, freshman warning, academic suspension and academic dismissal. Chapter and/or council officers in these situations please be aware that if this is your second consecutive term with a GPA under a 2.0 you are no longer eligible to hold office.

Those chapter members that did not complete the term, attended a different college, or did not have any hours for an average were listed on the individual chapter grade report, but may not

have been averaged into the chapter's grade average. If your organization takes into account grades from other institutions during the semester it's your responsibility to bring those transcripts to the Greek Life office.
