How do I enter?

Create an art piece or reusable item (e.g. purse made of juice boxes). It should be created from materials that would have otherwise been recycled or thrown in the garbage (e.g. used computer parts, scrap metal, old clothing).

Complete an entry form.

Drop off your artistic entry to Adam Ferrando in The Burrow (SR 151) by 4 p.m. on Monday, October 19, 2009.

Will there be prizes?

YES! Prizes will be awarded to students only, but faculty & staff will also receive recognition for their winning entries.

When will the winner be announced?

Winners will be announced on October 21, 2009 at the 10 a.m. tree planting ceremony in the Arboretum.

Are there any rules?

Yes, here they are:

- The contest is open to everyone at FAU with one division for students and one for faculty & staff
- One submission per person
- Entry must be made of recycled materials (with allowance made for materials needed to paint, fasten or adhere art together)
- Artwork must be safe (no hazardous materials containers, dangerously sharp edges, etc.)
- Judging will be based on the artwork's creativity & observance of contest rules
- Artwork must be labeled clearly with name, phone number and division (student OR faculty/staff)
- Art must weigh less than 15 pounds, or artist must be available to transport heavier art during contest period of Monday, Oct 19, 2009 – Friday, October 23, 2009

When can I get my artwork back?

Artwork must be picked up by artist no later than 4 p.m. on Friday, October 23, 2009, or it will be recycled. Pickup location is The Burrow (SR 151).
