NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATION AMENDMENT**

Date: September 28, 2006

REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: Standards of Student Progress (formerly “Degree Requirements”) (2.003).

SUMMARY: This regulation amendment incorporates suggestions from the Florida Board of Governors in response to the University’s prior notice of repeal of Regulation 2.003. This Regulation amendment incorporates statewide regulations which govern degree requirements.

Regulation 2.003 Standards of Student Progress

- (1) Florida Atlantic University (FAU) standards of student progress are defined in the official University Catalog. The catalog year determines the set of academic requirements that must be fulfilled for graduation. A student continuously enrolled at FAU may be awarded a degree by satisfying the degree requirements defined in any catalog in effect during the period of continuous enrollment leading up to graduation. Students must follow a single catalog to meet graduation requirements, not a combination of catalogs.
