His current research applies quantitative tools to expose and remedy social injustice, and is based out of the Institute for the Quantitative Study of Inclusion, Diversity, and Equity (QSIDE), which he co-founded. Dr. Topaz is also Professor of Mathematics at Williams College and, previously, at Macalester College, where his research on complex and nonlinear systems has been supported by the National Science Foundation from 2006-2021.
