HOW TO CONNECT TO FAU'S INTERNET

Before you can surf the web, stream videos, play online, etc. You need to register your device with FAU.

1. Connect to the FAU wireless network from your wireless device (e.g., laptop or mobile device).
2. Your browser should automatically direct you to our registration site, if not, please go to talon.fau.edu, and sign in using your FAU ID and Password.
3. Once in our FAU Network Device Registration System, enter a name for your device (ex: Joe's laptop) and the MAC address should automatically appear in the box. (If the MAC address does not auto-populate, please visit our site for instructions on how to find it at fixit.fau.edu)
4. Accept the Use Policy and then click **Register Device**.
5. You have successfully added/registered your wireless device!
