<p>Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>STA 2023 - per Lincoln Sloas (see attached)</i></p> <p>For the combined BA/MS CCJ program, we would like to require a grade of "B" or better in both undergraduate research methods and the statistics courses as part of the admission requirements. By making this change, the admission requirements for the combined BA/MS program will align with the admission requirements for the traditional MSCCJ program.</p> <p>We would also like to change the program description for the combined BA/MS CCJ program to read: "The B.A./M.S. in Criminal Justice combined degree program will enable outstanding students to graduate with both a Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice and a Master of Science in Criminology and Criminal Justice, in as little as 5 years. The program is 153 credit hours (B.A./M.S. with thesis or non-thesis tracks). Students complete 120 hours for the undergraduate degree and 33 hours for the graduate degree. Students complete the undergraduate degree first, taking no more than 12 credit hours of graduate coursework in their senior year, which can be used to satisfy requirements for both degrees. Prospective students must formally apply to this program and meet all admission requirements." This change provides clearer language of the program than the previous program description.
