We are making a change in our Curriculum requirements for all department majors. Currently, in the catalog we have it listed that Theatre majors may opt to take either LIT 2040 Interpretation of Drama, LIT 3043 Modern Drama, or LIT 4094 Contemporary Drama in lieu of one of our Theatre Lit Classes. We want to remove this as an option for the students to select and reserve it for the faculty advisor to select in those circumstances where scheduling conflicts necessitate it. So while we will keep those courses as options, we want it at the discretion of the advisor. Therefore, we would like to remove the option visually from the catalog.
