Hi Dale:

While our graduate courses in TESOL & bilingual education address the topic of pronunciation, the extent of overlap is negligible as we address matters that are theoretical and practical in the teaching of pronunciation to multilingual speakers. Hence, we see NO conflict.

There are a few edits that you might want to take note:

1. The word "assignment" is spelled incorrectly on the bottom of page 1 where it says incorrect spelling will be penalized.
2. In our experience, a new course proposal was supposed to not have an instructor's name and specific dates in the syllabus. You might want to check if this is not necessary anymore.

And just out of curiosity, would this course address multilingualism so that students of this course can gain an appreciable difference between language difference and disability/disordered speech?
