Art Minors *

The Department of Visual Arts and Art History offers a minor in Art History and one in Studio Art with the following areas of study: Ceramics, Drawing, Graphic Design, Painting, Photography, Printmaking and Sculpture. All courses must be completed with a "C" or better. Satisfactory/unsatisfactory or pass/fail grades will not be accepted. Studio Arts and Graphic Design majors may minor in Art History, but are not eligible for other Studio or Graphic Design minors. Students cannot minor in their own major area, i.e., Art History majors cannot minor in Art History. Art majors are not eligible for these minors. Interested students should contact the department for advising in the appropriate minor.

The minor in Art History includes a minimum of 19 22 credits. At least 16 19 of the 19 22 credits must be taken at Florida Atlantic University.
