The Linguistics Minor is being brought in line with the Linguistics Major that was revised recently. The Major no longer includes language-specific concentrations, so "focus on a single language" is no longer applicable. Instead, students will be able to choose language-specific linguistics courses as electives. Clearly listing of TSL4080 & TSL4251 as possible electives will make it easier for students to combine the Minor with the ESL Studies Certificate (both TSL courses can count towards the Certificate). Allowing one lower-division elective will make it possible to count one IFP LIN course (LIN2001 or LIN2607) towards the Minor. Removal of the sentence "75 percent of all minor credits earned must be from FAU" will bring the Linguistics Minor in line with the description of most other minors in LLCL that do not state this requirement in the catalogue description.

Linguistics Minor in (with a focus on a single language) (15 credits)

To complete a minor in Linguistics, with a focus on a single language, students are required to pass (with a grade of "C" or better): Introduction to Linguistics (LIN 3010), a course in the structure of a language (LIN 4680, FRE 4850, SPN 4850 or ITA 4730), one of the following upper-division core two courses in theoretical linguistics (LIN 4326, LIN 4802 or LIN 4430), and two upper-division (3/4000-level) linguistics elective courses in linguistics (6 credits), to be chosen in consultation with the LLCL advisor (other LIN courses, in-lingua linguistics courses, TSL 4080, TSL 4251; only one elective can be lower-division). At least 75 percent of all minor credits earned must be from FAU.
