ENT 4412 will replace ENT 4114 as a required course in the Entrepreneurship concentration, and ENT 4114 will be moved to the elective list within that concentration. MAN 3113 will be added to the elective lists in both the Entrepreneurship concentration and the Leadership and Applied Management Skills concentration. We are also eliminating two courses from the list of electives in the Entrepreneurship concentration (MAN 4602 and MAR 4836).</p> <p>The Entrepreneurship concentration changes will improve the alignment of that concentration with the current state of the field and our faculty capabilities. CATALOG CHANGE: MANAGEMENT MAJOR

EXPLANATION

We are creating two new courses, Entrepreneurial Finance (ENT 4412) and Managing Workplace Diversity (MAN 3113), and inserting them into the Management major. ENT 4412 will replace ENT 4114 as a required course in the Entrepreneurship concentration, and ENT 4114 will be moved to the elective list within that concentration. MAN 3113 will be added to the elective lists in both the Entrepreneurship concentration and the Leadership and Applied Management Skills concentration. We are also eliminating two courses from the list of electives in the Entrepreneurship concentration (MAN 4602 and MAR 4836).

The Entrepreneurship concentration changes will improve the alignment of that concentration with the current state of the field and our faculty capabilities. Adding MAN 3113 to both concentrations is consistent with University efforts to promote awareness of diversity and inclusion issues.
