Re: Change of Degree from BA or BAE in Music Education to BME

The Department of Teaching and Learning and the Department of Music propose a title change for the degree BA (or BAE) in Music Education to Bachelor of Music Education (BME). The degree title Bachelor of Music Education is offered under the same CIP code as our current degree at Florida Gulf Coast University, Florida State University, University of Central Florida, University of Florida, University of North Florida, and University of West Florida.

Florida Atlantic University is accredited by the National Association of Schools of Music, which has renewed accreditation for the current BA in Music Education at Final Approval for Listing. NASM and CAEP have a reciprocity regarding accreditation, so the degree is also CAEP accredited.

NASM considers Bachelor of Music degrees as professional in the field; Bachelor of Arts is reserved for non-professional, liberal arts music degrees. Therefore, FAU's current title for the Music Education degree is perceived as a non-professional degree, which our departments view as a recruitment and retention issue for our students.

The curricular content and management of the degree, including assessment, will remain as currently structured. The only change is regarding the title.
