# FAU Studio Art Photography-Curriculum Updates

The information below serves to update the photography course descriptions, pre-requisites and requirements for students seeking a BA, BFA or an Art Minor. The updates are necessary to ensure students take the courses in the appropriate sequence, the program is competitive and comparable to institutions similar to FAU and to allow for the implementation of the flight plans for photography – guiding students towards graduating in a timely manner.

In addition to the updates, I am terminating Photography 1 and Photography 2 (both analog) as they have been replaced with Digital Photography 1 and Digital Photography 2. The darkroom and film photography are still essential components of a fine art photography education so a new Black and White Photography course has been created. Advanced Photography will no longer be repeatable as the photo flight plan indicates it is designed for students that are in their senior year/last semester. The Advanced Photography curriculum includes very specific, sophisticated projects (including a professional practices component) that build on the skillset gained in the 4 other photography courses students take prior to enrolling.

Topics will become a required course, to be offered once a year. This course will have a Digital Photo 1 pre-requisite and will therefore serve not only students concentrating in photography, but also BA and Art Minor students as well. The topics course is necessary to provide a more complete photographic education and is the only way to bring in essential subjects such a photographic lighting, documentary photography, alternative process, etc. This addition will require that one additional photography course be taught per year. Applied Photography drops off as an optional course for students concentrating in photography as it is solely taught on the Davie Campus and in practice is geared towards serving the graphic design students on that campus.
