This memo requests approval for (1) creating a new course (Directed Independent Research EVS 4916, 0-3 credits, S/U) and (2) adding the existing courses, Green Consciousness (WST 4349, 3 credits) and Environmental Journalism (JOU 4314, 3 credits) to the Human-Environmental Interactions Focal Area of the Environmental Science Certificate. These existing courses address issues that are central to Environmental Science but that are not covered thoroughly in other courses in the Certificate.

The Environmental Science Program Committee voted unanimously for the changes described above. Letters of support are provided from the Center for Women, Gender & Sexuality Studies and the School of Communication and Multimedia Studies.
