Re: IDS 3949 Credits Date: March 23, 2017

In conjunction with the FAU Career Center, we are requesting a change in IDS 3949 from 0-1 credits to 0-4 credits. Students will be asked to complete a minimum of 60 hours of internship and associated coursework for 0-1 credits, 90 hours for 2 credits, 135 hours for 3 credits, and 180 hours for 4 credits, consistent with the Provost's policy and guidelines on credit hour definitions. We are requesting this change for a number of reasons:

- 1. To offer more options to students. Currently, some students take this course multiple times but with this change students will be able to take it a single time for more credit.
- 2. To assist the IDS online degree. We are currently working with the Center for eLearning to launch an online version of the IDS degree. That degree requires 3 credits of internship, which students will be able to fulfill through this online course.
- 3. Better reflects actual internships. Most students devote significant hours to their internships. They can now have that work reflected in course credits.

We believe this is a simple change and we hope you will support it.
